The Department of Mathematics and Statistics of Calvin College invites applications for one full-time tenure-track faculty position, pending administrative approval.

About the position

An advanced degree in mathematics, mathematics education, statistics, or a related discipline is required for this position; a PhD is preferred. Candidates should have outstanding promise as classroom teachers and actively pursue a program of scholarship. Strong applicants in all specialties of mathematics and statistics will be considered. Pending final administrative approval, the appointment will begin August 2016.

About the department and the college

The department offers majors and minors in mathematics and mathematics education; cognate courses for programs in the sciences, engineering, public health, and education; and courses for the general education requirements of the college. Teaching responsibilities are determined based on the expertise and interests of the faculty and the needs of the department.

The department currently has 12 tenured and tenure-track faculty members and graduates approximately 20 mathematics majors per year, 30-40% of them in the secondary education program. Several recent alumni are currently graduate students in mathematics, statistics, or biostatistics. In addition, many of our majors and minors pursue graduate degrees in other disciplines.

Calvin College seeks faculty who affirm the Christian faith as expressed by the Reformed confessions and who have academic and personal qualifications for teaching and scholarship. Calvin is building a tradition of diversity and accessibility and welcomes applications from persons whose personal characteristics will further that commitment.
