Candidates will meet the following requirements:

Education / Experience – to provide skilled background for the job tasks:

- A minimum of MA in Mathematics or Education with advanced credits in mathematics
- A minimum of 2 years of higher educational teaching experience
- An ability to teach a wide range of mathematics classes including remedial courses
- An ability to design curriculum and assess the effectiveness of curriculum
- A positive reputation as a scholar and educator
- A well articulated philosophy of education

Special Skills – to apply professional and/or technical tasks to the job responsibilities

- An ability to relate to undergraduates and to help them understand the ways in which mathematics apply to the shaping of their thought processes, their future careers, and their biblical worldview
- An ability to work with colleagues on corporate projects
- An ability to coordinate with mathematics adjuncts in the areas of course scheduling and development, classroom practice, and assessment methods
- Proficient as a communicator in written and oral formats
- Proficiency with general computer skills
- An ability to design instruction
- An ability to develop new courses
- A desire to mentor students outside the classroom

Job Tasks – to determine specific tasks required of the position

- Develop and teach a wide range of mathematics courses including remedial courses; required full-time teaching load is 4/4
- Oversee the revision of the mathematics curriculum
- Monitor ongoing assessment of students in the area of mathematics
- Participate in Arts and Sciences department meetings and activities
- Maintain regular office hours of at least 10 hours a week for student and faculty consultation and support
- Complete other tasks as related to the department and requested by the department chair
