Hannibal-LaGrange College is seeking a full-time mathematics instructor.

Hannibal-LaGrange College (HLG) is a private, Christian liberal arts college in the historic Baptist tradition and upholds the biblical positions on moral and ethical issues. The College's mission statement and its affiliation with the Missouri Baptist Convention prescribe that faculty appointees are professing Christians, actively involved in the church of their choice, and have values consistent with Baptist tradition. Because HLG promotes a biblical worldview and a Christ-centered approach to education (Col. 1:18), prospective faculty must be able to articulate that worldview and educational approach in their work and life. Qualifications: Graduate work must be in mathematics with the PhD preferred, the master's required. The successful candidate will (1) demonstrate a commitment to excellence in undergraduate teaching, (2) teach both developmental and upper-level mathematics courses, (3) participate in student recruitment, advisement, and program development, and (4) articulate a Christian Worldview in both work and life. Experience with online courses would be beneficial.
